UkkoHiisi has been created with deep respect for Finnish woodcraft, the beliefs of our ancestors, living in harmony with nature, and the seasonal communal celebrations rooted in the cycle of the year.

Our activities and menus draw their inspiration from Finnish mythology. Culinary experiences are prepared over an open fire using traditional methods: lake fish caught from our own shore, game, berries, mushrooms, wild herbs, and local beverages.

People have lived on the UkkoHiisi peninsula for thousands of years before us – and will continue to do so long after. The place is said to make time stand still: its stories, landscapes and silence envelop visitors in a unique connection with nature. It is often said that UkkoHiisi is more than an extraordinary destination; during your visit, it may become a state of mind.

UkkoHiisi offers guided experiences with dining options tailored to the size and wishes of your group. All activities are led by professional guides with safety as a priority.

To conclude the experience, the entire group gathers around a feast table, accompanied by an impressive traditional drum ensemble, and the experience is crowned with coffee brewed in a soot-blackened pot over open fire.
