

Kuopio Dance Festival is participating in the North Savo Kaikukortti experiment. The aim is to offer cultural experiences to young people, adults, the elderly and families in a financially tight situation. Culture belongs to everyone!

Kaikukortti holders can purchase free tickets to our performances for themselves and their children or grandchildren under the age of 18. Tickets must be for the same performance and children must be in the card holder's Kaikukortti register. If the owner of Kaikukortti has an assistant, they will also receive the ticket free of charge.

Tickets can be booked one month before the event by email or by calling. When booking tickets, you must provide your name and Kaikukortti number. Tickets are delivered printed and labelled to the box office of the venue, where they can be picked up before the performance. When picking up your ticket, show your Kaikukortti card and be prepared to verify your identity as well.

Kuopio Dance Festival's quota for reserved tickets is predetermined (10 tickets for large performances and 5 tickets for small performances), but tickets can also be requested from the ticket office without reservation one hour before the performance. Kaikukortti holders can get a ticket free of charge if there are still seats available for the performance.

You cannot buy tickets from the online store (Lippu.fi) with Kaikukortti.
